Measure 42 is marked with a red '42' and contains a sequence of 3-string sweeps on the high strings (1, 2, 3) for the A chord. The second system of the guitar tablature consists of measures 41 and 42. Measure 41 is marked with a red '41' and contains a sequence of 3-string sweeps on the low strings (4, 5, 6) for the Asus4 chord. Measure 42 is marked with a red '42' and contains a sequence of 3-string sweeps on the low strings (4, 5, 6) for the A chord.
